(This is why students must add that 'in accordance with certain course requirements required for the award of B.Sc degree.' The space is also reserved for all registered signatures. Dedication page: This is where researchers devote research to a denomination, someone dies or/and lives. This is different from being acknowledged. Note: Researchers here write to appreciate everything that is involved, (technical, financial, moral and otherwise) to the success of research. Abstract: This is the conclusion of the research. Typically, less than 100 words, summary statements, problems, methods used, findings, conclusions and recommendations. This value should be in a single paragraph and not exceed the term limit. Table of Contents: The main headers and subheadings and page numbers are listed. This makes it easy to identify and reference pages. The final table of contents should also be edited to capture reflections on the work correctly. Table List / Numbers / Symbols: The list is to help readers find tables/numbers/symbols.
